Time and Place in Schedule of Classes

The Chemistry Workshop is open to all students concurrently enrolled in CHEM 221 who want to increase their understanding of chemistry by putting a little extra time and energy into problem-solving and exploration of concepts that are fundamental to the study of chemistry. Workshop problem and activities are designed by faculty teaching the lectures. The course is P/NP only, with the requirement for passing being regular attendance and participation in the workshop. There will be no exams and no outside homework. We expect workshop students to be highly self-motivated learners who will gain by sharing in the learning process with others. This is not a remedial program. It is open to anyone who has the background to be in Chemistry 221 and wants to enhance his/her learning.

Students who enrolled in workshops last year often improved their chemistry grades by one level or more.
