Cathlapotle Unit N174-176 W89-90 West Profile Illustrating Typical Hearth Deposits.

1= A horizon soil. 2 = Hearth: each occurrence is a distinct hearthfeature, characterized by compact burned earth containing much indurated bone and charcoal, with few or no artifacts.

3 = Massive sand stratum, free of artifacts or charcoal; hearth 'lining'.

4 = Sterile parent clay.

Areas A and B have distinct stratigraphic cuts which suggest a hearth box.

Hearth shown is Feature #478.

Elevation at excavation floor=5.35mASL.
