

Cathlapotle N159-160 W91-95 North Profile Illustrating Typical Sheet Midden and Wall Features.

- 1= A horizon soil. 2 = Sheet midden stratum outside plankhouse; each occurrence is a lense of sand with a noticeably high charcoal and artifact content.
  - 3. Massive sands containing little to no charcoal or artifacts.
  - 4 = Wall construction feature in area A; each occurence is a clear cut into strata. In area B, plank molds indicate plank fortification to sub-floor pits.
    - 5. Dark organic silty sand pit fill: some hearth deposits are evident in area C. Unmarked lenses are non-artifact-bearing, charcoal-free massive sands.

Elevation at excavation floor (far W)=4.62mASL.
