



The flake edge, photographed at 100x, was used to shave (a work action most commonly understood as 'whittling') a one-inch diameter fresh willow (*Salix* spp) branch for 30 minutes. The edge is rounded, small rugosities are missing, there are several small microflakes, and a bright polish has formed on large surfaces. With further use, the edge may become much duller and more rounded, and the polish may become more invasive.
