There is a very small risk that someone will find out your name and answers. In order to safeguard against this, we are asking you to fill out the survey anonymously. We will not collect your name or any other identifying information on the survey. We will also report information about groups of people, not individual answers, so it will not be possible for readers to know who said what.

What will I gain by taking part in this study?

You will not gain anything directly by taking part in this study. However, if you participate, you may be helping us learn about how students learn, and so help students in future courses.

What happens if I decide not to take part in this study?

You do not have to take part in this study. Your participation is voluntary. You can change your mind and stop at any time. Whether or not you participate will not affect your relationship with the researcher *Sam Super Student*, the Applied Linguistics Program, or Portland State University.
