

For each set of elements given, create two sentences. In the first sentence, put the verb in the subordinate clause (the clause beginning with “*si*”) in the **present**. In the second sentence, the same verb should be in the **imperfect**. For each of the sentences, you must conjugate the other verb appropriately (see remark below). Note that you must add articles and prepositions when needed.

**Remember:** the form of the verb in one part of the clause determines the form of the verb in the other clause. The verb in the main clause should be conjugated accordingly. (See the model.)

**NOTE: you may find it easier and less confusing to write all the "a." sentences first, then go back and do the "b." sentences.**

MODELE: Si / tu / venir / ici, / je / te / rendre visite.

a) Si tu viens à Portland, je te rendrai visite. (SI + présent <—>futur simple)

b) Si tu venais à Portland, je te rendrais visite. (SI + imparfait <—>conditionnel)
