age of Montesquieu, Voltaire, Diderot, Rousseau, and the "Encyclopédie"

1789-1815: The Revolution and the Napoleonic Era (end of the *ancien régime*)

1789: first year of the French Revolution

1804: the "Empire" (Napoleon crowns himself Emperor)

1815: Waterloo: final military defeat of Napoleon

1815-1848: The Restoration of the Monarchy; The Bourgeois Monarchy

1815: Monarchy of Louis XVIII

1830: The "July Revolution:" reign of Louis-Philippe, the bourgeois king

1848-1851: The Second Republic

1848: Revolution, Establishment of Second Republic (end of Fr. monarchy)

1852-1870: The Second Empire (Napoleon III, Emperor)

1870-71: Franco-Prussian War

1871-1940: The Third Republic
