## **Study Questions:**

Sum up the changes to French government and society that occurred from 1789 to 1795.

Why did the Third Estate object to the proposed organization of the Estates General? After it convened, what tangible form did the deputies of the Third Estate give to their opposition (June, 1789)?

The "Tennis Court oath" centers upon one of the main reforms to the *ancien régime* sought by the Third Estate and other "enlightened" deputies. What was this reform?

What was the impact of the Revolution on the church in 1789/1790?

What was Louis XVI's fate? Who was responsible? Why was this development significant for future debate on the form of government in France?

What was the general reason France went to war in 1792? (see E&G, pp. 12-13) What role did the *émigrés* play in these "Revolutionary wars?" Why did France go to war <u>after</u> 1802? What European nations were involved in the wars with France?

What contributions did Napoleon's empire bring to Europe?

Where was Napoleon exiled (2 answers)? What period separates the two exiles? What event sealed his fate once and for all?
