CONFLICT as a SOCIAL FORM

GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS OF CONFLICT

- •Conflict instinctual for humans
- •Unique feature of conflict for humans: it is goal oriented
 - •Opens up opportunities for negotiation and different types and levels of conflict

VARIABILITY OF VIOLENCE

- •Clearly expressed with rational goals → less violence
- •Higher emotional involvement → increased violence
- •Transcendent goals → greatly increased violence

FUNCTIONS OF CONFLICT

- •For society at large—low-level/less violent, more frequent conflict
 - •Releases hostilities
 - •Creates norms for dealing with conflict
 - •Develops lines of authority and judiciary systems
- •For individual groups—more violent
 - •Strengthens the boundaries surrounding the group
 - Increases social solidarity
 - Centralizes power
 - •Fosters coalition formation
