DURKHEIM'S Influence:

- Several generations of French Sociologists
- •Functional anthropologists, especially Levi-Strauss
- •Levi-Strauss brings Durkheim to Chicago, circa 1930
- Parsons includes Durkheim in SSA, 1937
- •Leads to Merton and American sociology in general
- •Influence on post/neo-Chicago school, e.g. Goffman
- •Combined with the general sociological tradition in social constructionism, e. g. Berger
