

THE INTRICATE WEB OF PATTERNED, MULTIPLE RELATIONS BETWEEN INDIVIDUALS IN CONSTANT INTERACTION.

THE INDIVIDUAL AND THE GROUP ARE MUTUALLY CONSTITUTIVE VIA SOCIAL FORMS, I.E., CRYSTALLIZED PATTERNED INTERACTIONS.

- large group



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
SOCIAL RELATIONS:
