 - Date
 - Name
 - Speaker affiliation
 - Title of presentation
 - A question that you would ask the speaker based on her/his talk
- Submission of a typed list of seminars attended at the end of the term, with the above information for each talk (date, name, affiliation, title, question, plus location/event if outside of ESM). The typed list may either be dropped off during the last seminar, or emailed to the instructor as a Word attachment. These lists must be received by the final seminar session (Friday, Dec 5, 2008).
