Friday and Saturday night, May 13 and 14, **CAMP** at Shelton Wayside, crest of the Ochoco Mountains near Fossil.

An introduction to the geology of the Western Blue Mountains and adjacent areas of central Oregon. Integration of field data concerning rock types, paleontology, stratigraphy, folding and faulting to interpret paleoclimate, regional geologic patterns, and landscape evolution.

Course fee of \$90.00 is included in your tuition and fees billing from PSU. No refund of transportation fee after May 1st.

Sign up into cooking groups (up to 6 people per group) in Geology Department office (Cramer Hall, room 17) as soon as possible. If you would like to cook on your own, you may do so (but it's more work!). Information/equipment list will be furnished when you sign up for a cooking group. **No private cars will be allowed**. Trip is limited to 55 participants.

All assignments for this course are completed during the trip. You will receive a guidebook on the bus at the start of the trip. This guidebook is to be completed and turned in when we return to Portland State University on Sunday evening.

You may attend this trip without taking the G 200 course for credit. To do so, you must sign up for the trip and pay \$90 at the Department of Geology office in Cramer Hall 17. Deadline for sign up is May 9.
