To run an already existing program:

From the home screen, go into the var-link menu by pressing <code>[2nd]</code>—, put the cursor on the program name and press <code>[ENTER]</code>. This will bring the program's name to your home screen. You must place a "closing" parenthesis at the end of your program's name, e.g.

ration()

Pressing **ENTER** will run the program.

To edit an existing program:

Go into the Program Editor, possibly $\boxed{\mathsf{APPS}}$ $\boxed{\mathsf{7}}$ $\boxed{\mathsf{2}}$. Choose the program and press $\boxed{\mathsf{ENTER}}$. Make any changes and then press $\boxed{\mathsf{2nd}}$ $\boxed{\mathsf{ESC}}$, which saves the program.

<u>Note</u>: Be Careful that you don't make any changes that you do not want. After your write over a line and exit, the change is made for good.

To enter a NEW program:

Go into the Program Editor, possibly **APPS 7 3** and enter the program's name.

Type in the code.

Pressing 2nd ESC saves the program.

To transfer programs from calculator to calculator :

• Plug the cable firmly into both calculators.

$\underline{Receiver\ calculator}\ :$

• Press 2nd - F3 2 (Set this calculator aside)

$\underline{Sending\ calculator}\ :$

- ullet Press [2nd] [-] . Use the [F4] key to check off programs you want to send.
- Press [F3] 1 to transmit the programs.
- ullet Done. **ESC** out.
