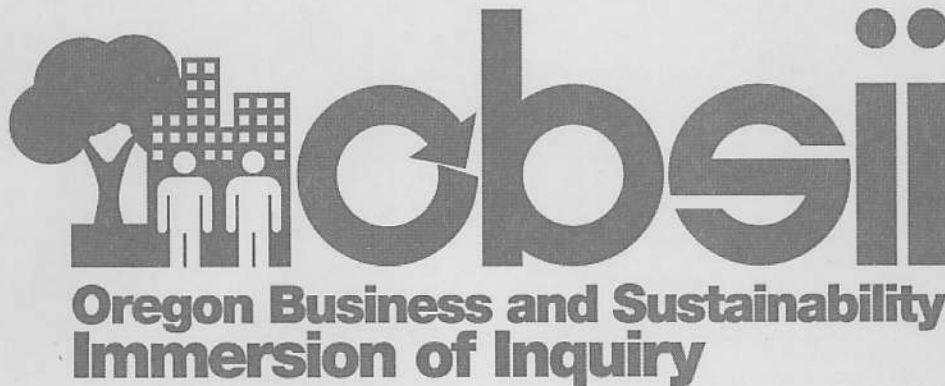


Summer Short Course

What will the course look like?

- “Persistent Inquiry and its Role in Sustainability-Inspired Businesses” (first day workshop),
- Visits to and conversations with 10-12 leading sustainability-inspired regional businesses,
- Exploring Innovation in Nature (Saturday, August 21st)
- Collaborative Inquiry Colloquium (final half day workshop).
