HOW TO SHOP ON A GERMAN ONLINE STORE

With so much advancement in "international exchange" through the Internet, it is fairly easy to navigate through online-shopping facilities in a language you don't know, provided you learn the basic vocabulary for online shopping in whatever language you happen to be shopping. In the German language, a good place to start exploring would be by entering the word "geschenke" in a search engine. This word means "gift." Though you may not be looking specifically for a gift, it is a good starting place to become more familiar with online-shopping in the German language.

Whatever website you choose to explore first, there are some key words on the "Startseite" (or home page) that you may find right away. One would be "Produkte," which looks close enough to the English word "product" to, in fact, be the product the website is selling. Another word you may see on the "Startseite" is "Warenkorb." Most of the time, you will see an image of a shopping cart next to "Warenkorb," which is also a good indicator that clicking on this link will lead you to your shopping cart, or shopping basket. (Unless it means you're a basket case ☺)

Clicking on a "Produkte" link may lead you to a few different categories. If you find yourself in a department store (quelle.de is a good one), you may see words that look extremely similar to the English language. More often than not, they will mean the same thing! Also consider that because online shopping does not allow you to see the product in person, there should be enough pictures on the site to lead you to the product in which you are interested. If you are looking for a certain German brand name, be on the lookout for the word "Marken," which will lead you to lists or symbols of the specific brands carried by the store. You might also see the words "für Ihm" or "für Ihr or Sie" or "für Kinder," which simply mean "for Him," "for Her," and "for Children." If you know the German word for something specific but don't know what category to look under, find on the home page the text space followed by the word "suchen," and the site will be searched for your product.

The word "Angebote" should be a favorite for bargain shoppers, as it will most likely be a special "offer," and "sparen" will indicate some amount or percentage of savings off a product. When looking for the price of a product, the word "Preise" may be near a Euro sign with numbers. Should you decide to order something, clicking on "Bestellen" or "jetzt bestellen" will add the product to your

“Warenkorb.” If you are done shopping and want to head to the checkout page, find and click a link with the word “Kasse” and you will be lead to the appropriate page.

There may be other issues you are concerned about with your order, such as arrival times and shipping costs. A link to look for in this case would be “ABG,” which will likely lead you to a page that covers these kinds of issues. Words to look for in that page may include “Versandkosten” (shipping costs), “Senden” (send), “Stunden” (hour), “Zahlen” (pay), as well as words containing “Tag,” which means “day.” Another link to look for if you have questions about the product or the website would be to find the words “Fragen und Antworten,” which means “question and answer.” This, however, may lead you to more advanced language. If you needed to contact the website, then the word to look for would be “Kontakt.” This can lead you to phone numbers, 24-hour service, emails, addresses, or any other contact information you may need.

Though each website is going to be different, becoming familiar with a few online-shopping terms may help you navigate through the sites with more ease than you thought. If all else fails, you become impatient, or you give up on trying to understand the unfamiliar language, there is a pretty good chance that many sites have their own English-language versions! But for the purposes of learning the language and how to shop in the language, succumbing to the English version sites will only hinder your learning.

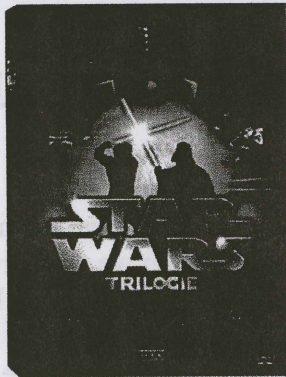

Guidance for Online Shopping in German

Tackling a shopping trip online with a foreign language is much easier than it sounds. The advantage of being a native English speaker is that when we are perusing German sites for that perfect gift, we can look at cognates. German and English have very similar words, especially in the world of new age technology and shopping online. Some helpful German words to know that are close to English cognates on these sites are things like Hilfe (help), Artikel (think "articles", "articles" like "items"), Summe ("Summe" sounds much like "sum," which could equate to "total"), and Kontakt (contact).

However, not all terms are going to be close to their English equivalent. Another good thing to remember is that many websites have icons that describe what the function of the link is for. For example, you may find a little picture of a shopping basket next to the word "Mein Warenkorb." Next to the word "Suchen," there is generally a little search bar that looks just like the ones we use on English sites. You can also apply this technique to exploration.

Another good tool is to just have fun and explore the site. Using said bits of advice, you can figure out what departments are which and what they might carry. Click around and take a look at the pictures for context.

English Instructions:

It is easy to shop German websites if you stick to the basics. Also it is important to remember

German e-shopping websites are layed out much the same as any English speaking site you have been to.

First off have an item you're interested in already in mind this will help you to search for the item with

more confidence. Another important thing to remember is that a lot of German websites are bilingual in

German and English. If you're drawing a blank on where to begin your search try using the German

Google search engine: www.google.de.

With that in mind begin a search using simple one word or short phrase search criteria, for

example: Valentine's Day Gift, ^{Bier} Beer (Beir in German), Jewelry, Clothing, etc. As I said before most

German websites are bilingual but it would not hurt to know the German word for what you're looking

for. For example, the German word for gift is Geschenk. These translations are relatively easily found

with the use of an online dictionary; however, make sure that you're getting a good translation by using

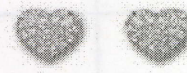
