# Shopping

Shopping on the internet can be confusing enough as it is, let alone in a different language. However, it can also be really simple if you know just a few simple phrases and words. With a handy-dandy list of core words, you can conquer any foreign language website sufficiently!

When searching the internet, a few core words go a long way. For example, in my project my dream gift was a bottle of wine for my mom. More specifically, I wanted to find her a nice bottle of red wine. So, the word for "red wine" is "rotwein." I entered the word into my preferred search engine, except it wasn't specific enough. I also searched for words such as

"geschenke" and "einkaufen" along with "rotwein."

Some foreign language websites will have the option of an English version of the page (or French sometimes if that happens to be your preferred language) but not all do. Don't worry, though! It's still simple. What will come up is the "startseite," which is the home page. You'll probably notice that a lot of the terminology will be very similar to English when it comes to links. Chances are if it sounds very much like an English word, it means what you think it means. Often (if not always) there will be a search tool somewhere on the page, usually near the top. It will say "suche," which means "search" in German. Enter your key phrase or word into that bar and click "suche".

Hopefully at this point some things have popped up relevant to what you are wanting. If not, continue to try with different matching phrases. Maybe include a specific location ("Küche" would be handy to tack on to whatever specific kitchen object you are looking for as it may narrow the search down). Once you've found what you are looking for, it will usually list a price and a description. The price is easy to figure out – it will usually say "Preis" along with whatever monetary amount. Make sure to search for the word "Sonderverkauf," as this means "sale" and could save you some money.

When you have finally found what you are looking for and are ready to buy, there should be a button nearby that says "bestellung." This is the magic word, as it means "to place an order" which I'm hoping since you've gone this far and made this much effort you will want to do so! This will then go into your "Warenkorb," or shopping basket. You can then proceed to check out. If for whatever reason you are unable to buy your item or just want to

save it for later as a helpful hint, then you can add it to your "Merkliste."

It will become easy to figure out as you go. Trial and error will help you along. It is also helpful to keep on hand a conversion chart for US dollars into Euros, but also a chart for size conversions as sizes in clothing here in America do not always translate over into Germany. These can easily be found when searched for in any search engine.
