Portland Public Schools and other school districts use sample student work, including mathematics assignments, for training purposes. Before the student work is used the child's name, the teacher's name, the name of the school, and any other identifying marks are removed. The student's grade level is left on the work.

This student work is used in classrooms to show students the kind of work that meets state standards and the kind of work that does not meet state standards. It is also used at meetings of teachers, parents, and others to explain the quality of work which will meet state standards and to provide examples of acceptable and unacceptable work. A particular student's work is chosen by teachers for this use because it can be helpful in teaching others, and because the problem or attribute which it demonstrates is common among students.

Your authorization may be withdrawn at any time by sending that request to the Research and Evaluation Department, Portland Public Schools.
