Rule of thumb for 4: Gets through the situation in German, with help (& not much) only on the complication

| 6 Comfortably manages BOTH the situation AND the complication with minimal help. | see Global Function | Almost no searching for vocabulary. Uses several verbs, nouns and modifiers special to the context. Basic morphology and syntax solid. | see Global Function | see Sit. 1 |
| 5 Handles the basic situation comfortably, but needs more than minimal help with the complication. | see Global Function | most of 6 | see Global Function | see Sit. 1 |
| 4 Gets through the situation in German, with more than minimal help only on the complication. | see Global Function | Uses several terms special to the context. Habitually (& correctly) conjugates verbs, codes gender, and maintains word order. | see Global Function | see Sit. 1 |
| 3 Gets through the situation with some help, and the complication with some struggle | see Global Function | most of 4 | see Global Function | see Sit. 1 |
| 2 Struggles through the basic situation; cannot field a complication. | see Global Function | Repeated flaws in language even of Kontext 3 & 4. | see Global Function | see Sit. 1 |
| 1 Starts but cannot finish the basic situation | see Global Function | Even the language of earliest units is scant. | see Global Function | see Sit. 1 |
