

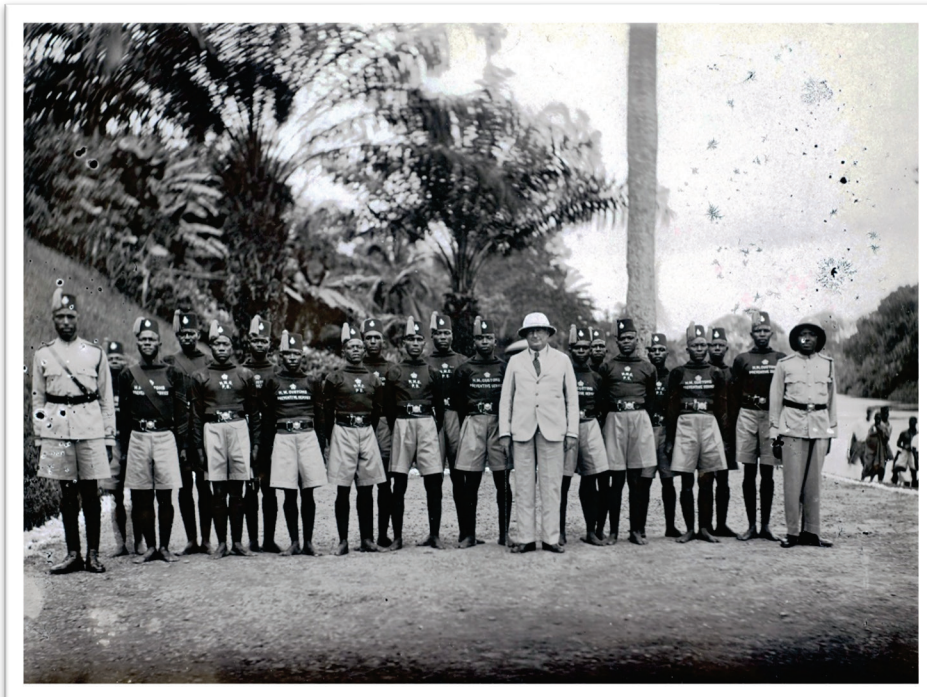
Contributions of Western Colonialism to Human Flourishing: A Research Bibliography
