

Access to SPSS at PSU

There are several ways to access SPSS at PSU.

- One way is to use a computer on campus that has SPSS, and most if not all of the Psychology faculty have SPSS loaded on their lab computers and SPSS is generally free for installation on campus owned computers.
- A second method is to go to a physical location of a lab on campus. The lab locations are listed here, and reportedly all have SPSS loaded:

- Finally, there is a PSU virtual lab which you can log into with PSU credentials and use remotely. I've tried this before and it works pretty smoothly. There are pretty detailed instructions here:

- You certainly do not need to purchase SPSS, but if you are interested in having a version on your laptop, you can rent the grad pack for 6 months from several vendors, such as
https://studentdiscounts.com/?adoper=174258_2_OT1. The "Base" version is \$34 and the "Standard" version is \$50 for 6 months. The Base version does not have regression analysis which we will use a little this term and a lot next term.
